

STUDENT PARKING – APPLICATION & INFORMATION

2022-2023 Academic Year

NUNM maintains several lots designated for students, faculty, staff and guests. **Students need to complete and submit a new parking application for each term by the Friday of the first week of classes:**

September 16, 2022 – Fall Term application deadline **January 7, 2023** – Winter Term application deadline **April 7, 2023** – Spring Term application deadline

New this year: In addition to full-time parking permits that are good Monday – Saturday (\$107), students may now purchase a part-time permit, good for three days per week (\$65). Students will need to indicate which three days of the week they will park on campus on their application.

- Parking applications must be returned by email to parking@nunm.edu no later than 5 pm on the first Friday of each term.
- Parking hang-tags will be placed in student mailboxes during the second week of each term.
- Specific lots will be designated as part-time or full-time student parking based on demand. These details will be announced the second week of the term.
- The fee is \$107 each term for a full-time parking permit or \$65 for a part-time permit. Your student account will be billed directly.
- Daily permits may be purchased at the NUNM Bookstore (Academic Building, Room 115) for \$5. Make sure you plan in advance so that you have a permit available on the morning you need it!
- Do not park in the white or yellow spaces that are marked "RESERVED" or "VISITOR."
- There is no student parking at Lair Hill Health Center or Helfgott Research Institute. Students who have a valid parking permit may park at HRI only for the duration of their class(es) in that location.

It's the first day of the term and I don't know where to park – help!

You may park in the lot ONLY if you have a hang-tag permit displayed on the rear-view mirror in your car. All others will be subject to a \$25 fine (see below). Please do not park in reserved or visitor spaces.

How does NUNM know that I can park in the lot?

NUNM security will patrol the lots daily. Your hang-tag permit must be placed on your rear-view mirror, facing out, so it can be seen from the front of the car EVERY DAY. Vehicles parked with no hang-tags will receive a warning, with second offenses resulting in a \$25 fine, charged to the student's account. Excessive violations may result in suspension of parking and/or towing. The hang-tag permit may be used on any car for which you provided information on your parking application.

During what hours are student spaces restricted?

Student parking spaces are valid from 6 am – 5 pm, Monday through Friday, unless otherwise instructed by the Director of Security. Evening and weekend parking in all non-reserved student spaces with white striping is open to all students, staff and faculty. Overnight parking is not allowed anywhere on the NUNM campus.

Can I park on the street?

The City of Portland WILL ticket cars parked longer than 2 hours. NUNM has no control over street parking regulation.

Indoor Bicycle Parking

A limited number of indoor spaces will be allocated by lottery to rent in the room behind the southeast bathrooms, across from Academic Building, Room 107. The cost is \$25 per term. If you obtain a space, you will be issued a key and the expense will be added to your tuition bill.

Applications must be submitted by 5 pm on the first Friday of the term. You will be notified the second week of the term by note in your mailbox if you have received a key. Keys can be picked up at the Safety & Security Office (Academic Building, Room 125).

Outdoor Bicycle Parking

The outdoor bicycle parking enclosure is available to NUNM bicycle commuters at no cost. The combination for the lock can be obtained from the Student Life Office (Administrative Building, Room 155), or in the Safety & Security Office (Academic Building, Room 125).
